The Canon Law Council is a body that is primarily involved in the development of Canon Law within the Anglican Church of Southern Africa. It is also a body that is a resource to the province by way of training for Diocesan Registrar's and Chancellors and at the same time is available to the Metropolitan and the Synod of Bishops for advice and guidance on Canonical and legal matters.

Nominees should ideally have a legal background and a keen interest in Canon Law.

In terms of the structure of the two pension fund boards, the 'employer' – the Anglican Church of Southern Africa – elects to 'employer' representatives to the Board of both funds with a term of office of three years. This is normally an appointment that is made at Provincial Standing Committee and as such the election at Provincial Synod 2021 will require a term of office until PSC 2023

Requirements:

- A good working knowledge of the Pension Funds Act
- A background in finance, law or the investment industry would be an advantage.
- Normally requires attendance at 8 meetings a year – 4 meetings for each pension fund.
- Possible appointment by the Board to various sub-committees of the pension funds.
